

Bitesize Uni 2024 - Subject Strands

A key part of Bitesize Uni 2024 is that you will attend up to three different subject taster sessions during your time with us. Bitesize Uni 2024 is split into 2 broad focuses: 'Arts and Humanities' and 'STEM* and Life Sciences'. The two different strands will attend Bitesize Uni on different dates.

Each subject taster session is hosted by Newcastle University academics and provides a great way for you to get an insight into the university and learn new skills, all of which will help you succeed in Higher Education.

As part of your subject strand, you may be allocated taster sessions that are in subjects you haven't considered before; we encourage you to keep an open mind as you may learn something new, including skills, interests, experiences and more.

When you apply to Bitesize Uni, you will select which subject strand and its associated dates you want to take part in. You will not be allocated to a strand or dates you have not applied to.

You can choose from the following options:

Arts and Humanities: Sunday 14 July – Tuesday 16 July

 - Accounting and Finance, Archaeology, Architecture, Classics, Digital Cultures, English Literature and Language, Geography, History, Linguistics, Marketing, Modern Languages, Music, Philosophy, Urban Planning

STEM* and Life Sciences: Wednesday 17 July – Friday 19 July

- This may include tasters in:
 - Agriculture, Animal Science, Chemical Engineering, Computing, Dietetics, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Environmental Science, Human Nutrition, Marine Science, Sport and Exercise Science

* STEM: Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics
