### Details

We are currently putting together a series of sessions for our PARTNERS Academic Summer School running at the beginning of July for which we are seeking a range of alumni and industry professionals to get involved in.

The PARTNERS Programme is a Newcastle University initiative in which eligible students from low income or disadvantaged backgrounds can receive a conditional offer up to three grades lower than the standard entry requirements. It has supported over 7000 students into Newcastle University since it was established in the year 2000. To receive their PARTNERS offer all students must take part in the Academic Summer School so this is a vital component of the programme and allows us to make an early impact on this target group of students to help improve their graduate outcomes.

As part of the 2022 Summer School we will be running a series of 19 Ask the Experts online webinars based on the strands you can find listed below. Our Science & Engineering session will be taking place on 5<sup>th</sup> July and the Humanities & Social Sciences sessions will be taking place on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July.

Webinars will consist of a maximum of three industry professionals and alumni who will provide a short 5-10 minute talk on their background, any organisation they are representing and a brief overview of their career history. The students in attendance will then be given the chance to ask panellists their questions with the session lasting a total of 1 hour\*.
